Our Mission

In response to the redeeming love of Jesus Christ, Martin Luther School challenges mind and body and shapes Christian character so that students succeed as God's people in this world.

Martin Luther School is a parochial, Lutheran coeducational high school founded in 1960.

Accredited by the New York State Board of Regents and the Middle States Association.

College preparatory curriculum with an emphasis on Christian values.

Annually, more than 98% of the graduating class continue their education in two or four year colleges.

Curriculum

English: Students are required to complete four years of study in English. Honors courses are offered in grades 10, 11, 12. As juniors and seniors, students may take an elective in addition to the regular full unit of English.

English electives include:

AP English Writing Workshop

Mathematics: Students will complete Algebra I, Geometry and Algebra II. Honors courses are offered at all levels except Algebra I.

Mathematics electives include:

Pre-Calculus AP Calculus

Science: Students will complete three years of science. MLS offers Biology (Living Environment), Earth Science, Chemistry, Physics. As juniors and seniors, students may take an elective in lieu of a lab science.

Science electives include:

AP Biology AP Chemistry
Marine Biology AP Environmental Science

Social Studies: Students will complete four years of social studies. As juniors and seniors, students may take an elective in addition to the regular full unit of Social Studies.

Social Studies electives include:

AP U.S. History AP European History

Physical Education: Students are required to complete .5 units of Health and 2 units in Physical Education. The physical education curriculum develops skills for the well-rounded individual in a variety of sports.

World Language: Students will complete two years of Spanish,

Mandarin, German or American Sign Language. A four year course sequence is available in each language. Independent study is available to any seniors who wish to complete additional study in Spanish, Mandarin and German.

Theology: Students are required to complete 2 credits of Theology. Courses provide opportunity for students to grow in faith and to acquire knowledge of God, themselves and others.

Music: Students must complete at least one music class. An audition is required for Concert Choir.

Credit Requirements College and AP Course Information

Students admitted to Martin Luther School are permitted to take a maximum of eight credits per year. All one credit classes are a full school year. All half credit classes meet every other day for a full school year or everyday for one semester.

In order to receive a high school diploma from Martin Luther School, a student must:

- Complete the 24.5 units of credit listed below.
- Complete 32 hours of community service

*note: One-half unit of theology credit is required for each year a student is in attendance at Martin Luther School.

Credits Required for Graduation

- English 4 units
- History 4 units
- Mathematics 3 units
- Science 3 units
- Foreign Language 2 units
- Physical Education 2 units
- Theology 2 units*
- Health .5 unit
- Technology .5 unit
- Art .5 unit
- Music .5 unit
- Electives 2.5 units
- Total: 24.5 units**

Students may earn as many as 30 credits toward their college education while still in high school. Classes through Monroe College, Concordia College - NY, Pace University, and St. John's University some options include: Intro to Criminal Justice; Intro to Business; Elements of Chemistry and Conservation and Pollution of Biology; Probability & Statistics and Intro to Sport Management.

Students may secure college credit through the Advanced Placement Program. Students are selected to take AP classes based on their average from the previous school year. The number and specific courses offered each year are dependent upon enrollment.

MLS Grading System

- Passing grade - 70%
- All subjects including Physical Education are included in the grade point average
- Courses are designated R to denote NYS Regents, H to denote Honors, AP for Advanced Placement, COL for College Level Courses
- Grade point average reflects a student's weighted average
- Students are ranked by grade point average.
- College Courses, Honors courses, and AP Courses are weighted.
