Students must follow our dress code policy:

- Unvaccinated Middle School Students will test monthly between Oct.14-17, Nov.11-14, Dec. 4-7.
- Unvaccinated High School Students will test monthly between Oct. 28-31, Nov.27-30, Dec. 17-20.

If you have a child in Middle School and High School, please test on the Middle School Schedule.

Fully Vaccinated individuals are not required to test. If your child is fully vaccinated, please submit a copy of their card if you have not already done so. Reminder: A person is considered fully vaccinated 2 weeks after completion of a 2-dose series or a 1 dose series.
