

The Martin Luther School After School Program provides a supportive and enriching environment for both MLS and non-MLS students beyond regular school hours. It will run from 2:30 pm to 5:30 pm. The program is designed to promote well-rounded growth among students by offering a diverse range of activities, including academic assistance, creative and recreational programs, and opportunities to explore STEM fields.

Key Activities:

Homework Help:

- Dedicated time for students to complete homework assignments.
- Experienced student counselors are available to assist with any challenges.
- Emphasis on fostering independent learning skills.

Tutoring:

- Individualized tutoring sessions to address specific academic needs.
- Tailored assistance to reinforce understanding and improve academic performance.
- Regular assessments to track progress and identify areas for improvement.

Arts and Crafts:

- Creative expression through hands-on arts and crafts projects.
- Encourages imagination and enhances fine motor skills.
- Opportunities for students to showcase their artistic talents.

Music Instruction:

- Structured piano lessons for students interested in music.
- An experienced student counselor will provide comprehensive musical education.
- Opportunities for performances and recitals to showcase progress.

Board Games and Puzzles:

- Engaging and strategic board games to promote critical thinking.
- Puzzles and brain teasers for cognitive development.
- Fosters teamwork, communication, and healthy competition.

STEM Activities:

- Hands-on STEM activities to explore science, technology, engineering, and mathematics concepts.
- Encourages problem-solving, critical thinking, and innovation.

- The MLS After School program will be held at Martin Luther School.
- Offered to students 5th grade through 9th grade.
- Program runs from 2:30 PM 5:30 PM.
- Starts February 1st, 2024 (First full day)
- Ends on June 21st, 2024.
- Students can attend 1, 3, or 5 days a week.

Payment Information

- You will be charged **monthly** and **pay the same price every month.**
- There are **no credits or refunds** for any **unused days** (including *holidays, shorter months, and days that school is not in session*).
- Payments are due upon receipt of each month's billing statement. If payment is not received by the fifteenth of the month, student(s) will **not** be able to attend.

Fee Schedule (MLS Students)

- 1 day per week (monthly payment of \$100)
- 3 days per week (monthly payment of \$150)
- 5 days per week (monthly payment of \$250)
- Drop-in rate of \$30
- Tutoring Only: \$25/ DAY (until 4:00 PM)

Fee Schedule (Non-MLS Students)

- 1 day per week (monthly payment of \$150)
- 3 days per week (monthly payment of \$200)
- 5 days per week (monthly payment of \$300)
- Drop-in rate of \$35

Sibling Discount Schedule (30% off)

- 1 day per week (monthly payment of \$70)
- 3 days per week (monthly payment of \$105)
- 5 days per week (monthly payment of \$175)
- Drop-in rate of \$21
- Tutoring Only: \$30/ DAY (Until 4:00 PM)

Sibling Discount Schedule (30% off)

- 1 day per week (monthly payment of \$105)
- 3 days per week (monthly payment of \$140)
- 5 days per week (monthly payment of \$210)
- Drop-in rate of \$24.50

Program Rules and Guidelines

General Rules:

- 1. A counselor will review the expected behavior and rules with the participants regularly.
- 2. Follow directions given by program staff.
- 3. Treat peers, counselors, facilities, and equipment with respect.
- 4. Stay within the designated area; only leave the group or region with an After School Program Counselor.
- 5. Any behavior jeopardizing the safety of others or staff is not tolerated (e.g., spitting, throwing objects, pushing, hitting, biting, threatening violence, bullying).
- 6. No use of foul language, drugs, or inappropriate clothing is allowed in the After School Program.

Discipline:

In case of rule violations, the following disciplinary measures may be taken:

- 1. Counseling:
 - a. The student will receive counseling, and the counselor will discuss expectations for behavior change.
- 2. Reflection:
 - a. If a student's behavior persists, they may take a 5-10 minute reflection break, and the frequency/severity of their behavior may be recorded.
- 3. Parental Contact:
 - a. In case of repeated disciplinary issues, parents or guardians will be notified in writing with a Disciplinary Report Form that outlines the unacceptable behavior.
- 4. Suspension:
 - a. A student consistently disregarding instructions may face a one-day suspension, with the parent or guardian being informed.
- 5. Termination:
 - a. If a child's behavior is consistently unacceptable, parents or guardians will be notified, and the child may be dismissed from the program.

This approach aims to address behavioral concerns while fostering a positive and inclusive environment for all participants in the After-School Program.
