### **Our Community**

Founded in 1960, Martin Luther School is a Lutheran, co-educational middle and high school serving students from across the five boroughs and Long Island. We are proud to reflect the diversity of New York City, with students from a wide range of cultural and ethnic backgrounds.

### **College Credits**

Students may earn up to 30 college credits during their time at Martin Luther School through both in-person and online college-level courses. In-person courses are offered through partnerships with St. John's University and Concordia University – Nebraska, including:

- Calculus I (MAT 1730C)
- General Biology (BIO 111)
- Anatomy & Physiology (BIO 243)
- Sports Management, Sports History, Sports Psychology
- Introduction to Psychology (PSY 1000C)
- Beginning Spanish I & II

Online dual enrollment courses are also available through partnerships with Arizona State University and Grand Canyon University, allowing students to explore a variety of academic disciplines and earn credit before graduation.

### **Graduation Requirements**

To earn a high school diploma from Martin Luther School, students must:

- Complete 24.5 course credits
- Complete 32 hours of community service
- Pass 5 New York State Regents exams

Students may earn up to eight credits per academic year. Half-credit courses meet either every other day for a full year or daily for one semester. All students are required to complete Leadership & Faith Formation and Physical Education (PE) each year of enrollment.

Once graduation requirements are met within a subject area, students are encouraged to pursue advanced or college-level coursework to further prepare for college and career success.

## Curriculum and Accreditation

Martin Luther School is accredited by the New York State Board of Regents, New York State Association of Independent Schools, and the Middle States Association. We bring together a college preparatory curriculum and an emphasis on Christian values.

## Grading System—Passing grade: 70%

- All subjects including Physical Education are included in the grade point average.
- Courses are designated with a COL for college-level, and Honors to denote honor level courses.
- Grade point averages reflect a student's weighted average; honors and college level courses have a greater weight added.
- Students are ranked by weighted grade point average.
